

## **Emergency-Animal Rescue**

**Grade Range:** K-4

### **Lesson Objectives**

Students will review the School to Career - Inside View: Riverhead Foundation site to identify all the jobs essential to a marine animal rescue operation.

### **State Standards**

English, Language Arts, Career Development and Occupational development

### **Technology and Materials Needed**

- Web site listed in related links below.
- Any materials needed by students for presentaion: paper, poster sheet, markers, crayons, tape, scissors, etc.

Students brainstorm a list of all the people/jobs they think are needed to rescue a marine animal in distress.

Students then review the entire Inside View: Riverhead Foundation site.

Small student groups then compare and contrast their original class list to their revised list. Each group reports their findings to the entire class.

### **Assessment Criteria**

Assessment of oral presentation and written list. Group oral presentation, videotaped if possible. Students will evaluate their own presentations.
